

Report on the Effect on Electric Ratepayer Classes of Ordinance No. 20231005-033



On October 5, 2023, Council adopted Ordinance No. 20231005-033, establishing the power supply adjustments, community benefit charges, and regulatory charges effective for electric utility bills rendered on or after November 1, 2023. As required by Texas Utilities Code § 33.103, this report states the effect of the ordinance on each class of ratepayer.
